

## Concordia Lutheran Shootout Rules

1. Squadding: Squadding information available at check-in, and subject to change.
2. Tie Breakers: Ties will be broken by pre-selected station, this includes all team and individual placings.
3. Protest Procedure: Protest should be initiated immediately to the field referee and can only be initiated by the shooter. No protest will be accepted from parent and/or coaches (for youth).
4. Code of Conduct: The current 4-H/FFA Code of Conduct will be enforced both on and off the field during this event. Shooters, volunteers, family members or observers may be expelled from the event, match or grounds for failure to comply. Shoot Management reserves the right to refuse future registration to any shooter who does not comply with current 4-H/FFA Code of Conduct. No horseplay is permitted.
5. No shot loads larger than 7 1/2 .
6. Clay Carts: Golf carts and ATV's are to be used in an appropriate manner. No "mudding", driving fast or off course. No one under the age of 16 is allowed to drive a cart.
7. Safety meetings are mandatory and are held before each flight.
8. Safety glasses and hearing protection are to be worn on the course at all times by everyone.
9. Gun actions are to remain open at all times. Gun actions are not to be closed unless if participant is in the shooting station, ready to shoot.
10. Guns are to be unloaded before leaving the shooting station.
11. It is each shooters responsibility to ensure that his/her gun is safe to operate.
12. Should a gun misfire or jam, the shooter must clear the gun prior to exiting the shooting box. Misfired/Dud shell(s) shall remain in the shooters possession, or turned into the Range Marshall. At no time shall an unfired or Dud shell be placed in the waste bins.
13. No more than two rounds shall be loaded in a gun at any time.
14. When loading, shotgun shall remain pointed only to the shooting area. The shotgun shall never be pointed toward the infield when loading.
15. Shooters shall not proceed to the next station, until all members of the team are finished shooting.
16. While on a shooting course, the Range Marshall is the absolute law, and his decision is final.
17. **No alcohol** shall be brought onto the property.
18. Guns are to be pointed down range at all times.

19. Mulligans are for awards only for youth, they will not be considered for final score placed on Iclays.
20. Safety Agreement: All competitors will be required to complete a safety agreement prior to picking up their registration packet at the event. This agreement will be emailed to all competitors to the email address provided during registration. Agreements will also be available at check-in. Shooters will not be allowed to compete without a completed agreement. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
21. No refunds will be permitted after November 26, 2019, even if entry is made after this date.
