10 shots Each: Prone, Sitting, Kneeling and Standing
- Open Precision Standing Air Rifle –**
60 shots Standing

- **TEAM ENTRIES:** Open to teams consisting of four (4) firing members representing a club as defined by NRA Smallbore Rifle Rules, section 2.

Since the 3P team matches are unfired (paper team match), all teams **MUST** be named and entered **BEFORE** any member of the team begins individual firing. Alternates must also be named before firing and used to substitute only for someone who has not yet fired. Team members must fire their scores at the same sectional and location.

- **Orion Targets and the Orion scoring system will be used.** Orion is an Electronic Scoring system that automates the scoring process using an image processing algorithm. It is more consistent than manually scoring targets and removes the human factor. The electronic scoring ensures all shooters are treated equally.
- Competitors will be able to view their targets and if there are concerns:
 - If a shot value is not a reasonable interpretation of the actual shot and will be corrected by the stat officer.
 - If the stat officer (or jury) determines that a shot is correctly scored and a competitor still has concerns, the target can be rescanned. The rescan will re-score the target which may change other scores on the target.
 - Orion targets will not be manually plugged.
