A LIFE OF FAITH - WHAT IS FAITH?

**HEBREWS 11:1-3** "Faith is the confidence in what we hope for and assurance of what we do not see."

**HEBREWS 11:16** "... longing for something better – a heavenly place – the Kingdom of God that "THY WILL BE DONE ON EARTH AS IT IS IN HEAVEN" ...

#### **FUNDAMENTAL QUESTIONS:**

CAN WE TRUST GOD?

CAN WE TRUST JESUS?

DO WE MEAN IT WHEN WE SAY IT --- "THY WILL BE DONE ON EARTH AS IT IS IN HEAVEN?"

#### **LESSONS LEARNED:**

- 1. EACH EXHIBITED & EXPERIENCED EXTRAORDINARY FAITH, ESPECIALLY CONSIDERING THE CONTEXT OF their LIVING IN "PRE-HISTORIC" & "ANCIENT" OF TIMES ... TRULY PIONEERS IN KNOWING AND EXPERIENCING GOD THROUGH FAITH.
- 2. EACH WAS WILLING AND WANTING & ASPIRING OF GOD'S HEART AND GOD'S WILL.

THE HEART MATTERS!!!!!!!

- 3. GOD'S DIRECTIONS ALWAYS INCLUDE GOD'S PROVISIONS
  (ALTHOUGH OBEDIENCE OFTEN IS REQUIRED TO OPEN THE DOOR OF GOD'S PROMISES).
- 4. THE JOURNEY WAS CONTINUALLY "DAY-BY-DAY" and PROGRESSIVE "Tests of Faith" are used by God NOT TO CONVINCE HIM, BUT TO HELP CONVINCE US --- TO ENCOURAGE US, PREPARE US, and AFFIRM US --- THAT WE'RE MOVING CLOSER TO THE HEART OF GOD.

5. EACH "CLOSED DOOR," "DRIED UP CREEK," or "SEEMINGLY IMPOSSIBLE TASK" DOES NOT MEAN GOD'S REJECTION OR REPRIMAND BUT MORE LIKELY GOD'S APPROVAL AND ENCOURAGEMENT THAT YOU'RE READY TO MOVE-ON.

#### WHAT ARE SOME OBSTACLES TO OUR JOURNEY OF A "GROWING FAITH?"

1. PRIDE --- We trust ourselves more than we can trust God, so we fight against God.

WE MUST ACCEPT AND EMBRACE GOD'S WILL.

JOHN 3:30 ---- I MUST DECREASE AND HE MUST INCREASE.

- 2. FEAR --- God uses our loss of control and those things upon which we depend to BUILD our FAITH.

  WE MUST REASSURE AND REMIND OURSELVES --- THAT GOD LOVES US.

  WE MUST LEARN TO WALK BY FAITH.
- 3. RESENTMENTS & REGRETS -- As God peels back the layers of our accumulated baggage and sin we often relive buried hurts and angers that MUST BE LET GO WE MUST LEARN TO FORGIVE (& FORGET).
- **4. HABITS ----** our life habits and ways MUST CHANGE --- NO LONGER, "LIFE AS NORMAL" SO THAT WE MIGHT HAVE OUR HEARTS, MINDS, and SOUL TRANSFORMED TO BE AS GOD'S OWN HEART. **WE MUST LEARN HUMILITY** SO THAT **WE CAN ALLOW OURSELVES TO CHANGE.**

WHAT IS YOUR FAITH LIKE?

WHAT IS YOUR FAITH UP AGAINST RIGHT NOW?

#### MAY I ENCOURAGE YOU TO DO THE FOLLOWING - EVERYDAY POSSIBLE:

- 1. AFFIRM YOUR FAITH AND RESOLUTION TO KEEP YOUR FAITH & TO LIVE ACCORDINGLY (OR ELSE YOUR FAITH MAY STUMBLE & YOU MAY FALL).
- 2. DAILY TIME OF REFLECTION & PRAYER FOR THE DAY TO COME, YOUR CONCERNS, AND THAT "THY KINGDOM COME, THEY WILL BE DONE" in me and around me.
- 3. ASK GOD for ONE OTHER to SHARE 2-3 times per week, if not daily.
- 4. ASK GOD FOR 2-3-4 OTHERS TO SHARE & ENCOURAGE 1x1 --- and to SERVE TOGETHER.
- 5. ALLOW FOR A TIME DURING YOUR DAY FOR AFFIRMING PRAISE & WORSHIP MUSIC.

#### **BOTTOM-LINE**:

WHEN WE ARE SURE THAT WE ARE IN THE WILL OF GOD --- WE ARE INVINCIBLE!!!! ©

NEVER UNDER-ESTIMATE THE POWER OF A TOTALLY DEVOTED LIFE.

#### **AND REMEMBER:**

- a. WE ARE HERE BY GOD'S APPOINTMENT.
- b. WE ARE KEPT BY GOD.
- c. WE HAVE BEEN TRAINED AND PREPARED BY GOD, FOR WE ARE GOD's. "THE LORD IS MY SHEPHERD."
- d. WE ARE NEVER ABANDONED OR LEFT ALONE --- GOD WILL NEVER LEAVE US NOR FORSAKE US. "FOR SURELY GOODNESS AND MERCY WILL FOLLOW US ALL THE DAY'S OF OUR LIVES."

THANK YOU FOR YOUR UNDERSTANDING .... And, of course, we continue to offer 'online worship' and study opportunities. With love and care,




