Regulated Rate Option (RRO)

The RRO rate may increase or decrease from month to month as it is priced on the open market and subject to many factors relating to supply and demand. If you do not have a contract with an electricity retailer, then you receive the default RRO rate.

For November 2023, the RRO is priced at \$0.15048 per kWh, which is reflected on your enclosed bill. For December 2023, the Battle River Power Coop monthly RRO billing rate for FENN REA members is \$0.18339. The RRO rate is also listed on <u>www.fennrea.com</u>.
