- Basketball Project- Offer from citizen to assist in purchase and installation of new acrylic backboards and rims/nets (already purchased); Motion made to authorize up to \$2700 for completion of this project- Approved.
- Establish Park Board priorities- Capital Funding Committee survey should be completed at May meeting; Suggestion to have each board member try to monetize priority items listed, with those items over \$5000 to be considered for the Capital Funding survey; Also suggestion to discuss long-term plan vision for park as first step to setting priorities.
