

DRINKING WATER NOTICE

Monitoring requirements not met for RICHWOOD VILLAGE PWS

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards.

During the 2018 Annual time period we did not monitor for the following contaminants and therefore we cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water during that time:

TOTAL HALOACETIC ACIDS (HAA5).

What Should I Do?

This notice is to inform you that RICHWOOD VILLAGE PWS did not monitor and report results for the presence of the contaminants listed above in the public drinking water system during the 2018 Annual time period, as required by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency. You do not need to take any actions in response to this notice.

What Is Being Done?

Upon being notified of this violation, the water supply was required to have the drinking water analyzed for the above mentioned parameters. The water supplier will take steps to ensure that adequate and timely monitoring will be performed in the future.
