



Big Muddy Duck Hunt introduces hunting to young boys and girls

The Big Muddy Duck Hunt - is an annual, community-based waterfowl hunting event, designed to enhance waterfowl hunting in Holt County and Northwest Missouri through the recruitment of new hunters and the retention of those who already enjoy the sport. It is a collaborative effort from corporate sponsorship, private duck clubs, state government, and local waterfowl enthusiasts to invest in the future of waterfowl hunting. This year's event was held on Saturday, October 22, at Extreme Fireworks near Mound City with 22 boys and girls participating. The young hunters came from Offutt Air Force Base near Omaha, NE; the 139th Airlift Wing of the Missouri Air National Guard near St. Joseph, MO; the Boys' and Girls' Clubs of America from St. Joseph; and local boys and girls. Above, the youngsters were supervised by members of the Missouri Department of Conservation while shooting at clay pigeons. After attending five different duck hunting stations, the young hunters had the opportunity to go on a guided duck hunt, accompanied by a guide and a safety coach.

The station topics included duck identification, waterfowl regulations, duck calling, hunting strategy, waterfowl management and preparing waterfowl for consumption. In addition to these education stations, students attended two shotgun shooting stations. The station shown was teaching the young hunters about duck calling and strategic placement of decoys. The hunters went on a guided duck hunt later that day, accompanied by a guide and a safety coach.
