2016 YCKC Dragon Boat Competition

Get your team ready for YCKC's 3rd Annual Summer Dragon Boat Competition on **Saturday, August 13th, 2016!** **Ten** team members paddle the dragon, **one** member to beat the drum, and **one** to steer!

Book team practice sessions on beginning June 15th. All equipment is supplied—paddles, life jackets, and the dragon boat, including the dragon's head and drum! As well, a certified coach and lifeguard along with a safety boat are there to teach and protect.



What is YCKC? The Yorkton Canoe and Kayak Club (YCKC) is a non-profit organization dedicated to introducing and developing the Olympic sport of Sprint Canoe and Kayak in Yorkton and district. For 30 years now, YCKC has and continues to offer programs for all ages!

Dragon Boating is a new component under Canoe Kayak Canada, our national Olympic body of which YCKC is a member. YCKC has added Dragon Boating to its Learn-to-Paddle Program this season, and is now able to offer this exciting sport to Yorkton community! Here's how to get in the game:

- 1) Create a team of **11** (10 paddlers plus 1 to beat the drum) within your organization/business/family, or combine with another organization/family;
- 2) Give your team a unique name & **Register your team** with YCKC by **JULY 25th** — Form available on YCKC's Website
- 3) Book your **3** Team Practices – additional practices available for \$50/session
- 4) Pay Registration Fee at first team Practice. Cost is **\$60/person**.
Fee includes YCKC membership for each team member (CKS insurance), 3 dragon boat team sessions, team race **entry** to the Yorkton Developmental Regatta, and **1 YCKC drop-in session** for each team member;
- 5) Compete at the Yorkton Developmental Regatta – **Saturday, August 13th, 2016!**
