DESCRIPTION: This iconic BP Colt has been restored and enhanced. There was considerable varnish wear and limb stain, so I completed stripped the bow down and refinished it. Tip overlays have been added to strengthen and beautify. While an economical bow, the Colt has a well deserved reputation as a great shooter. Olla riser. Comfortable grip. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes; No chips, dings or cracks (Note: there may be a faint hair or joint line in the back of the riser below the arrow shelf (see pic on last page). No crazing or stress cracks. There were a few faint stress lines (no cracks) in the riser fade-outs that were filled and re-stained with white India ink, and then white oil-based poly. Up close you can tell the limbs have been refinished. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. I was not able to save the original decal in the refinish process, so the existing decal is a reproduction.
