## Cherry Vodka Jell-O Shots

A cool treat for Valentine's Day cheers.

## Ingredients

20-2 oz. plastic mini cups with lids 6 oz. box cherry flavored Jell-O
2 c . boiling water
2 c. cherry flavored vodka, ice cold 4 T. grenadine syrup
20 Maraschino cherries, with stems

## Instructions

Place plastic cups on a cookie tray. Place a cherry with stem into each cup and set aside.
Pour the cherry Jell-O powder into a medium mixing bowl. Add the boiling water and whisk until it is dissolved. Add the ice cold cherry vodka to the hot Jell-O mixture and whisk to combine. Add the grenadine syrup and stir to mix.

Carefully pour the liquid Jell-O mixture into each cup. Chill for at least 4 hours to allow the gelatin to "set." Put on lids and fill a plastic container with 2 levels. Pack in your picnic cooler.


## HEART SHAPED SANDWICHES

Use an oversized heart shaped cookie cutter to make these cute Valentine's Day sandwiches.

## Ingredients (use your favorite breads, fillings, veggies and condiments.) <br> 2 slices of bread for each sandwich <br> 2 slices of cheese for each sandwich <br> 2 slices of meat for each sandwich Veggies <br> Condiments

## Instructions

Cut bread, cheese and meat with oversized heart cookie cutter. Layer on 1 slice of bread: condiment, 1 slice cheese, 1 slice meat and veggies. Repeat layers and top with 2nd slice of bread. Secure with heart toothpicks and put each sandwich in a Valentine's Day treat bag, tied with a ribbon. Pack in cooler. Serve with heart plates and napkins.
