Gideon has come face to face with Jesus, and now has an important decision to make: what do you do when Jesus calls you to do something you don't feel qualified for?

Sept 1FavorJudges 6:17-18Gideon is both thrilled and scared that Jesus is pleased with him,
calling it "favor". Ironically, Gideon does what many of us do
when we want to make certain it's God calling us to do or be
the impossible: we ask for a sign.

Sept 8FearJudges 6:19-24When Jesus gives Gideon the sign he desperately wanted, Mr.
Favor freaks out. Who wouldn't? He just realized that he has
come face to face with the Faceless God! Would you respond
the same way if suddenly you realized you were talking to God
Himself? Does God want us to be afraid of Him?

Sept 15FatherJudges 6:25-32The first challenge God has for his mighty warrior is to deal with
his father's bull. (I'll wait for that to sink in.) Seriously! His dad
has a bull in the front yard that was a statue to a false god.
Many of us today have our own "daddy issues" that we need
to deal with if we're going to see God clearly.

Sept 22FightJudges 7Finally, the big battle has come!What does God do when weface an impossible fight?That's right, surrender!(No, seriously.)Surrender to Him, that is.When God tells Gideon exactly howhe's going to provide victory, Gideon has to decide to follow hisfear or follow the God who promised victory.
