Class Supplies List – Lone Star Quilt




CLASS INFORMATION	
Class name:	Lone Star Quilt
Description:	The Lone Star quilt is one of the most popular quilt designs of all time and still today. In this class we will create a wall size star, but I will teach you how to design any size Lone Star you will ever want to make in the future. This quilt requires precise cutting and piecing so the skills learned will be helpful for all your future quilt making. You will also learn to piece a Y seam.

	FABRICS:	
<input type="checkbox"/>	½ yard of 7 coordinating fabrics for the star diamonds.	
<input type="checkbox"/>	1 yard for Setting corners and triangles – this piece may not be used during the class time allowed. You may choose to NOT pick this fabric ahead but instead to choose it after you have completed the star sections – I will explain this in class. But if you have the “perfect” fabric for the settings, please bring it 😊	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Borders will be discussed but we will not work on them in class.	

SUPPLIES:

<input type="checkbox"/>	Rotary cutter, 45mm or 60mm size	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Rotary mat: Mat 18” x 24” is a must – a small mat will <u>not</u> work for this class.	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Ruler – 6”x24”, or 6½” or 8½” wide	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Ruler – a small ruler that is somewhere between 1”x6” or 3”x12” – it needs to be a quilters style ruler, not a school ruler	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Sewing machine	
<input type="checkbox"/>	100% cotton 50 weight thread for piecing – bring a neutral color that will blends well with the fabrics you have chosen for your star.	
<input type="checkbox"/>	New Sewing machine needle – Size 70 Microtex	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Freezer Paper – the teacher will supply this for class	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Glue stick	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Seam Guilds from Guildlines4Quilters. - these are the perfect tool for making the perfect scant ¼” seam allowance.	

<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>Straight pins – I recommend the Clover Silk glass ball head pins.</p>	
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>Spray Sizing – Mary Ellen’s Best Press</p>	
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>Marking tool that you can see on your pillow fabric. I would recommend a Frixion pen or a white mechanical pencil.</p>	
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>Good quality seam ripper</p>	
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>Glow Tape for your ruler is very helpful</p>	
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>Iron – students can share but only 2 students to an iron.</p>	
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>Flat hard ironing surface. A wool pressing mat is perfect as you will be able to pin you diamonds into the mat for block pressing. If this isn't available, please bring a large piece of cardboard – approximately 12"x20" – a Large Pizza box works great for this 😊</p>
