Dear Parents and Students,

Caddo Parish high school students will participate in mandatory nationally standardized testing on Tuesday, March 21, 2017. ALL juniors will take the ACT, and these scores may be reported to colleges for admissions purposes. Seniors who have not taken the ACT before the March test administration, or who have a composite score of 19 or below, will also take the ACT. Sophomores who signed up and paid a fee to take the Pre-ACT will also test on March 21.

There will be a mandatory pre-test coding session on March 14 at 8:20 am for all junior and selected senior students taking the ACT, and for registered sophomores taking the Pre-ACT. Students must arrive at school on time and should schedule appointments for the afternoon of March 14 or for another day. The pre-test coding session will last about one hour and students will report directly to their test sites no later than 8:10 am. The actual testing for the ACT will take place on Tuesday, March 21, 2017. Please do not schedule any appointments on March 21 for students who are testing, and students should plan to arrive at school by 8:10 am and report directly to their test sites. Cell phones and other electronic devices are prohibited in testing rooms. If a student has a cell phone in the test site, he or she will be dismissed from the test, and his or her answer document will not be scored. We recommend that students who are testing do not bring cell phones to school on March 21 unless they are able to secure them in a locker. Teachers will not collect cell phones in the test site, and the office is not prepared to ensure their security. Calculators are used on the mathematics tests, and students must bring calculators with them. Only approved calculators may be used for the math portions of a test, and calculators will not be provided by Magnet High. Teachers have a list of prohibited calculators, and a list may be found at <http://www.act.org/planstudent/tips/calculator.html>.

Testing will occur in the morning, and we expect lunch shifts to be delayed on March 21. Students should eat a hearty and nutritious breakfast that morning, and may bring a snack to eat during a very brief scheduled break in testing.
