The Special Meeting was called in regards to a major repair needed on the 2009 International Truck.

Highway Superintendent Herb Sady explained to the Town Board that the Exhaust Regeneration System failed and that the flanges rotted off. Attached is a copy of the "International Truck Corporation Exhaust Regeneration Process". The cost for this repair is \$8200.00 for parts alone, not including labor. The front springs are also gone on the truck. The cost for the springs is approximately \$1300.00, putting an extra spring on wing side.

Following a lengthy discussion, the following resolution was introduced.

Changing Terms of Office...the Town Supervisor's term can't be included at this time. In order to change length of Supervisors term it needs to be done 150 days before a biennial election. It needs to be done by resolution and not a local law.
