Bubble Gym Time

Our gym area will be opened at certain times during the week for small groups of people to use for their own activities. Examples: to go for a nice walk inside, a small game of basketball or soccer or pickle ball, toddler play. All you need to do is book a time slot! A max of 8 people per group. We will let you know if the activity is good with us (factors such as insurance may need to be considered)! An adult 18+ MUST be in attendance for the entire time slot. Times will be one hour. *Organizations/groups cannot book Bubble Gym Time slots*.

Our Kids After School Leisure Program is based on Canada's High Five® quality standard for children's recreation and sport. Our aim for this program is to provide the participants with a safe environment that promotes healthy child development, with a focus on being physically active!

Daily Activities will include:

- Zone play (imagination zone, building zone, active zone, quiet zone)
- We will spend as much time as possible outside
- Activities will focus on physical activity, fundamental movement and art

This is a semi Structured Active Play Program for toddlers and young children!

This program is all about learning the fundamental movements of early child development! It will incorporate activities around crawling, walking, running, skipping, climbing, jumping, kicking, tumbling, balancing, throwing and catching. Our counselors will lead the group through fundamental obstacle courses/activities for 40 minutes, followed by free play for 20 minutes.
