All individuals, firms, co-partnerships and corporations doing business in the City of Sunbury, Pennsylvania, are required to make application to the City Treasurer's Office for a license to conduct their business during the year beginning May 1, 2011 and ending April 30, 2012.

THE AMOUNT OF YOUR CITY LICENSE TAX WILL BE COMPUTED FROM THE WHOLE VOLUME GROSS OF THE BUSINESS REPRESENTED BY RECEIPTS IN CASH, OR THE EQUIVALENT THEREOF, TRANSACTED BY YOU FOR THE ENTIRE CALENDAR YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2011.

Tax is computed on basis of merchandise bought and sold. Do not include in return any income from products manufactured by you or for services performed.

New business shall pay tax based upon estimated receipts for one (1) calendar year. A copy of the ordinance will be furnished upon request. Each return must contain a properly executed declaration.
