STARS Annual Giving Opportunities

STARS began in 1984 with a simple goal: to let friendship and trust blossom into healing for the mind, body and spirit. The program matches specially-trained horses with participants guided by highly-skilled staff and big-hearted volunteers. Each year we serve clients diagnosed with physical, cognitive, and emotional disabilities. Helping them reach goals and dreams through the therapeutic work with horses. Horses offer several unique abilities most other animals cannot. Simply riding a horse rhythmically moves the client's body in a manner similar to a human gait, so clients with physical needs often show improvement in flexibility, balance, muscle strength, circulation and breathing. The unique relationship formed, with the horse and team of volunteers, provides such benefits as increased confidence, patience and self-esteem.

The following *GIVING OPPORTUNITIES* represent STARS annual fundraising campaigns that support our mission and our promise to our community: to provide persons with disabilities with an animal orientated therapeutic, rehabilitative, and recreational program that will contribute to their physical and emotional health. With your support in any of these program areas and fundraisers, you are enabling STARS to achieve extraordinary transformations in the lives of the individuals we serve.



Client Support

The Client Support Fund is an ongoing effort to support EVERY rider that comes through the Therapeutic Riding Program. STARS supports 75% of every client's tuition through contributions and fundraising. The remaining 25% is the responsibility of the client/caregiver. Client scholarships are available if financial assistance is needed. STARS will not deny a client services because of financial burden. Scholarships are awarded through an application process. In 2019 STARS provided over \$66,000 in tuition support.

For one client the total cost of a 6 week session is \$732. Contributions toward tuition support or the scholarship fund can be in any amount and will be a great benefit to clients right here in Siouxland.


