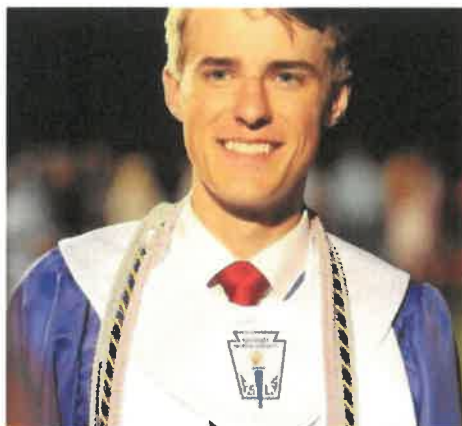

Devil's Food Pound Cake

From the Kitchen of Ann Rouse

Recipe from the FPC "Chosen to Serve" Cookbook

Ingredients:

1 devil's food cake mix
1 pkg. chocolate instant pudding
4 eggs
1 cup water
1/2 cup Crisco oil

Chocolate Glaze:
2 Tbsp. cocoa
1 Tbsp. plus 2 tsp. water
1 Tbsp. oil
1 Tbsp. corn syrup
1 cup confectioners sugar

Directions:

Blend all ingredients, then beat at medium speed for 2 minutes. Bake in a greased and floured 10-inch tube pan at 350° for 45 to 55 minutes. Cool right side up for 25 minutes. Remove from pan. Pour Chocolate Glaze over top of cake.

Chocolate Glaze: Combine all ingredients except sugar. Cook and stir over low heat until mixture is smooth. Remove from heat and beat in sugar.

1 head lettuce, shredded
1/2 cup celery, chopped
1 cup green peppers, chopped
1 onion, chopped
1 (8 oz.) pkg. frozen peas, thawed

1 cup real mayonnaise
2 Tbsp. sugar
4 oz. grated cheese
1/2 cup bacon bits

Directions:

Layer the 5 vegetables as listed in a cake pan. Spread with mayonnaise. Sprinkle with sugar, then cheese and bacon. Cover with foil. Refrigerate overnight.

Ingredients:

1 (12 oz.) pkg. cole slaw mix
2 to 3 Tbsp. unsalted shelled sunflower seeds
3 to 4 Tbsp. slivered almonds (optional)
1 pkg. Chinese noodle soup mix (Top Ramen, oriental)

Dressing:

2 Tbsp. sugar
3 Tbsp. cider vinegar
1/4 cup salad oil
Seasoning mix from noodles

Directions:

Mix first 4 ingredients together, breaking up dry noodles. Add dressing 15 to 20 minutes before serving.

Dressing: Shake or mix dressing ingredients together.
