



July 10, 2016 Fifteenth Sunday of Ordinary Time Luke 10:25-37

"What is written in the Law? How do you read it?"

A scholar of the law asked Jesus a question. Jesus does a very Jewish thing. He answered a question with a question. He asked, "What is written in the law? How do you read it?" Jesus knew the scholar knew the law. The scholar responds by quoting *Deuteronomy* 6:5 - You shall love the Lord your God with your whole heart, being, strength and mind and Leviticus 19:19 and your neighbor as yourself. Jesus tells him to do that and he will live. But the lawyer looks for a loophole, "Who is my neighbor?" Jesus tells the story of the "Good Samaritan." I have frequently traveled the road down from Jerusalem to Jericho in an airconditioned bus. In the time of Jesus the journey was on foot through baron, dry, hot hills and valleys. Jesus uses the story to ask the lawyer "Who was neighbor to the man set upon by robbers?" The lawyer states the obvious, "The one who showed him compassion." That should also be obvious to us. And the implications for how we should treat one another should also be obvious. Is it?
