## **PURPOSE:**

To define the uniform of District Chief Officers

## **RESPONSIBILITY:**

All District Chief Officers

## **PROCEDURES:**

### **1. Class A uniform**

- A. Navy double breasted dress coat with gold FD buttons (38804)
  - a. Sleeve braids on bottom of both sleeves (Chief 5, Deputy Chief 4, Assist Chief 3, Battalion Chief 2)
  - b. Gold service crosses positioned on the bottom of the left sleeve above the sleeve braids (1 cross for every 5 years of service)
  - c. Gold District Badge (Blackington B538) center scramble, Chief (A2963 BG Red), Deputy Chief (A2988 BG Red), Assist Chief (A2991 BG Red), Battalion Chief (A2994 BG Red)
  - d. Rank insignia positioned on the upper collar one inch from the collar point, Chief 5 Trumpets (4448G), Deputy Chief 4 trumpets (4447G), Assistant Chief 3 trumpets (4446G), Battalion Chief 2 crossed trumpets (4445G)
  - e. District patch on left sleeve two inches below the shoulder
- B. White long sleeve dress shirt (P877-3)
- C. Matching navy poly serge trousers (38200)
- D. Black 1 3/4" hi-gloss belt with gold buckle (1631U-G)
- E. Black hi-gloss oxford shoes (942)
- F. Black dress socks
- G. Navy bell crown cap with gold cap strap and gold cap insignia (114-1611)
- H. White nylon parade gloves (NYLON)
- I. Black clip-on tie (90010)

### **2. Class B uniform**

- A. White long sleeve (P877-3) / short sleeve shirt (P867-3) with District patch two inches below the shoulder on the left sleeve and an American Flag or the highest medical training on the right sleeve two inches below the shoulder.

- B. Navy blue straight leg pants (E814)
- C. Black 1 ¾" belt with gold buckle (6505-1-G)
- D. Black polished boots or shoes (Black socks with low shoes)
- E. Gold District badge (Blackington B538) scramble center scramble, Chief (A2963 BG Red), Deputy Chief (A2988 BG Red), Assist Chief (A2991 BG Red), Battalion Chief (A2994 BG Red)
- F. Gold name tag (first line: first initial, last name. Second line: rank) (Reeves Style 90)
- G. Gold service star above the name tag (1 star for every 5 years in fire service)
- H. Gold insignia trumpets 1" from the tip of the collar point and parallel with the collar support
- I. Black clip-on tie (only worn with long sleeve shirt) (90010)

### 3. Duty uniform

- A. Short sleeve District T-shirt White.
- B. Long sleeve District T-shirt White.
- C. District sweatshirt White.
- D. District polo shirt White (Navy District T-shirt will be worn under the polo shirt.)
- E. Navy straight leg or EMS Style duty/work pants. (E814 straight)(E7550 EMS pants)
- F. Black 1 ¾" belt with gold buckle (6505-1-S)
- G. Black polished boots or shoes (Black socks with low shoes)
- H. Duty approved shorts (PT26NV) with black socks and all black athletic shoes. (Only on PR assignments involving 8859)
- I. District Hat, Navy. (Optional) **Note: All hats will be worn facing forward.**

### 4. Sleeping Attire

- A. Short sleeve District T-shirt white.
- B. Navy athletic shorts or sweat pants.
