

ORDINANCE NO. 2016-1207

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SCHOOL ZONES AND SPEED ZONES FOR HARDIN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL LOCATED WITHIN THE CITY OF HARDIN, TEXAS ; PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLICATION OF THE CAPTION OF THIS ORDINANCE, EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF AND A PENALTY CLAUSE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HARDIN, TEXAS:

Section 1. That the City of Hardin, Texas, is hereby establishing a school / speed zone on TX HWY 146 in Hardin, Texas, as shown on the TXDOT Survey Map dated July 28, 2016:

The Hardin Elementary School zone shall be:

- (1) On TX HWY 146N beginning at the 55 mph speed limit sign south of the Hardin Elementary School
- (2) On TX HWY 146N extending to the end of the north property line of the Hardin Elementary School
- (3) Total length of proposed school zone to be 1,410 feet (0.267 miles)


Section 2. That the City of Hardin, Texas, is hereby amended by establishing the following speed control in the School Zone as shown on the TXDOT Survey Map dated July 28, 2016:

The speed limit for vehicles traveling the streets within the Hardin Elementary School zones during the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 8:15 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. to 4:15 p.m., school days, shall be 35 miles per hour maximum.

Section 3. The Caption of this ordinance shall be published one (1) time in a newspaper having general circulation in the City of Hardin, Texas and shall be effective immediately upon its passage and publication, and after all necessary signs have been installed.

Section 4. Any person who violates any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be subject to a fine not to exceed two hundred dollars (\$200.00).
