## Chapter 11

## We're Sorry But It's Time To Go

**BIBLE** 

All the assembly worshiped, and the singers sang, and the trumpeters sounded; all this [continued] until the burnt offering was finished.<sup>1</sup>

When they had finished offering, the king and all who were present with him bowed themselves and worshiped.<sup>2</sup> The four living creatures said, "Amen!" The elders fell down and worshiped.<sup>3</sup>

John answered, "A man can receive nothing, unless it has been given him from heaven.<sup>4</sup> Therefore do what we tell you. We have four men who have taken a vow.<sup>5</sup> But I hope that you will know that we aren't disqualified!"

The elders have ceased from the gate, the young men from their music.<sup>7</sup> They loaded their donkeys with their grain, and departed from there.<sup>8</sup>

All the people went their way to eat, and to drink, and to send portions, and to make great mirth, because they had understood the words that were declared to them. They broke down the pillar of Baal, and broke down the house of Baal, and made it a latrine, to this day. 10

## **BIBLE**

They drank wine, and praised the gods of gold, and of silver, of brass, of iron, of wood, and of stone. How attractive and beautiful they will be! Grain will make the young men thrive, and new wine the young women. Draw wine the young women.

They all ate, and were filled. They took up seven baskets full of the broken pieces that were left over. <sup>13</sup> So the people rested on the seventh day. <sup>14</sup>

After the seven days, the floodwaters came on the earth.<sup>15</sup> However the high places were not taken away. The people still sacrificed and burnt incense in the high places.<sup>16</sup>

Then Israel sang this song: "Spring Up, Well! Sing To It," a prayer of Habakkuk, the prophet, set to victorious music. 18 Those who sing as well as those who dance say, "All my springs are in you."

When the ark of Yahweh's covenant came into the camp, all Israel shouted with a great shout, so that the earth rang again.<sup>20</sup>

The whole assembly took counsel to keep another seven days; and they kept another seven days with gladness.<sup>21</sup>
