He has a huge heart.” That is what Michelle, a regular at the Salem NH Farmer's Market said when asked why she was at the Miner Family Farm vendor booth. Don Miner, a former marine, has been in business for five years at his farm which doubles as his yard seeing as he lives on the property in Merrimack, NH. His farm is home to about 35 cows and a large variety of other animals. At the Market he sells pork, chicken, lamb, bison, beef and duck eggs which are all available weekly. That is, if you get there before he runs out! By 10:30 duck eggs are usually sold out. At 10:38am on October 24, two customers asked to purchase

duck eggs to learn they were sold out and would find the supply replenished next week. When Miner found out he could not eat chicken eggs, he turned to duck eggs and decided to start selling them. Duck egg yolks are larger, brighter, and richer and are the best solution for those allergic to chicken eggs.
