PURPOSE It is the policy of the Immokalee Fire Control District to ensure that all federally funded programs and activities are in compliance with the requirements set forth for programs and projects that require the acquisition of real property (real estate) or displace persons from their homes, businesses, or farms.

The District and all its Sub Recipients or Contractors receiving grant funds shall comply with the Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act 1970, Surface Transportation and Uniform Relocation Assistance Act of 1987, [49 CFR Part 24](#), 24 CFR Part 42 Section 104(d), **Demolition or Disposition of Public Housing Projects; Final Rule Regulations (24 CFR Part 970)**, Codified 42 USC Sec 4601, and 42 USC Sec. 3537c. - Prohibition of Lump-Sum Payments, [HUD Handbook 1378](#).
