Come spend some time flipping, cart wheeling, rolling, bouncing, balancing, swinging, jumping, and playing with us! Gymnastics instruction will be based on fundamental progressions targeted to each individual child's needs. ## What should my camper bring to Camp?

Campers are to bring bag lunches (with drink) each day of attendance. The YMCA will provide one snack per camper each day.

Campers should wear clothing that is comfortable, practical, and easily washable. Campers MUST have sneakers every day! All belongings should be labeled with the camper's name.

We will swim each afternoon, so every camper should bring a swim suit, towel, sun screen and their water bottle in a clearly labeled backpack every day.

Field trips are scheduled every Friday. Campers should wear their camp t-shirts, bring lunches, water bottles, sunscreen, comfortable walking shoes, bathing suits and towels. **Please Note: Children must attend at least <u>2 days</u> of camp per week in order to be eligible to <b>attend Field Trips.**
