SECOND QUARTER WRAP UP

The GEM DIVISION was lead by the DART TRAIN with a 5 point lead in week 6. KATZ'S HEAVY HEAVERS catapaulted into first by virtue of a 29-10 victory in week 7 as HANK'S STEVE AND THE BIG GUYS moved into second by defeating the DART TRAIN 25-14 leaving the DART TRAIN third.

The GOLD DIVISION started week 7 with the CUBBYHOLE'S BAD COMPANY leading HANK'S PENETRATORS by 3 points and HANK'S BULLIES by 7. BAD COMPANY and HANK'S BULLIES scored big by duplicate 30-9 scores as the PENETRATORS fell to third with a 16-23 loss.

The SILVER DIVISION saw HANK'S TEAM EFFORT extend a 9 point lead in the 6th week into a 16 point lead with a 28-11 score in week 7. KIRKS JERKS hung onto second place with a winning score of 21-18 in the 7th week.

The BRONZE DIVISION was handily won by KATZ'S DART GODZ after scoring no less than 25 points in their 7 matches of the second quarter. The CUBBYHOLE SOUTHSIDERS finished with a 4 point hold on second place but 53 points behind KATZ.

The BLUE DIVISION had HIPP'S HEAVY-WEIGHTS leading the SHROYER INN by 6 points in week 6. In week 7 HIPP'S notched a 21-6 win over the SHROYER INN allowing CHEER'S SPIKES to grab second place and the SHROYER third.

The RED DIVISION saw the first place team, HANK'S HITMEN, and the second place team, CLANCY'S WHO CARES, hold the same position since week 2 with CLANCY'S closing within one point during the second quarter.

The ORANGE DIVISION'S HANK'S PARTY ANIMALS won first place by 15 points over NORTON'S SALOON PLATOON after HANK'S finished third in the first quarter of play and NORTON'S first.

The GREEN DIVISION was wrapped up by two of HANK'S PUBS entries with HANK'S BULLSHOOTERS taking first place by one point over HANK'S BANDITS. The BULL-SHOOTERS won their 7th week match 17-10 as the BANDITS tried to sneak into first by accumulating 21 points in their last match.

After switching positions in week 3, the YELLOW DIVISION'S CACTUS JOHN'S FU'S stretched a 6 point lead in week 6 to a 12 point first place win with a 22 - 5 victory with HANK'S PUB POUNDERS retaining second with a 7th week match of 15-12.

The WHITE DIVISION'S CHEERS' KILLER BEES moved into first place from fourth place in the 3rd week and never relinquished their hold as the SHROYER INN HOZZERS finished second.

After leading the BROWN DIVISION for three weeks, HANK'S SHOTS IN THE DARK slipped to second with a 7th week loss of 11-16 allowing the CUBBYHOLE BARGOYLES to overtake first with a 17-10 win in week 7.

The GRAY DIVISION witnessed the fiercest battle for first place as the LITTLE YORK TAVERN'S DEAD DARTMEN and CLANCY'S BANGERS had switched position three times since week 1. These two teams played at CLANCY'S week 7 with the BANGERS holding a 1 point lead over the DEAD DARIMEN ofter 6 weeks of play. In order to dispel any thoughts of home court advantage, LITTLE YORK prevailed 16-11 to capture first place by 4 points over CLANCY'S. This 1 - 2 finish was the same as the first quarter. Those with Weds. nights open may want to watch the 3rd quarter standings as this battle may continue!

The top three teams in the SCARLET DIVISION notched 18 - 9 victories to leave the entire Division's standings unchanged from week 6 with CACTUS JOHN'S DOMINATORS holding first over STAN'S BEASTLY BOYS.

The second quarter saw an increase of 180's in that 38 Members shot 44. The first quarter had 33 Members and 37 180's for a total of 66 Members and 81 180's. This represents approximately 10% of the present Membership attaing Darts highest score of three triple 20's with three darts. Approximately 2% shot 2 or more with 3 Members notching 3 180's, the 3 represent 1/2 of 1% of our league.

The Members in the 1/2 of 1% are: GENE CRAMER (GEM DIVISION, DART TRAIN), RON CLOUTIER (GEM, HANK'S STEVE & THE BIG GUYS) and CARY PICK-RELL (GOLD, PASTIME LANES).

Bracket A Members accounted for 60 [45 Members], Bracket B for 15 [15 Members] and Bracket C for 6 [6 Members]. The Gem Division led the way with 16 players zeroing in 26 180's with the Gold Division following with 15 players notching 18. The Brown Division is the only Divison that has not had a player attain Ton 80 status. But there is the second half to go.

CACTUS JOHN'S ALL STARS, GOLD DIV-ISION, now has 5 of their team's 6 Members on the 180 list with TODD DALY still in the hunt for the maximum score so CACTUS JOHN'S may boast of having the first team in the 1988-89 league to have ALL its Members attain Ton 80 stature. CACTUS JOHN'S ALL STARS are: AARON WINSTON, JOHN HODGES, SAM COTTERMAN, GREG HARRIS, RITCH COPE and TODD DALY.

***** KING OF THE HILL *****

LOU LOVASH has informed us that he will be directing a KING OF THE HILL DART LEAGUE in Dayton.

The league is affiliated nationally with King of the Hill Darts International. These leagues are already formed in several cities throughout the U.S. and now is being formed in Dayton.

The league offers an opportunity for players to play against others near their competetive level in a singles format. As the matches are played points are accumulated and standings tabulated so that the number 1 player would next play number 2, 3 vs. 4, 59 vs. 60, etc. This will allow players to be paired according to their skill level and a most competetive match ensuing. This provides players to hone their singles game against players they should be playing. Most leagues allow a person to shoot very few singles matches and this should bring tournament players level of play up.

Matches are scheduled by the league and players arrange times and places within a predetermined time period. Two matches a month are played by each member. Players could schedule any evening or day in order to play at their convenience.

There virtually will be no competition with any established league in Dayton or any new leagues if formed in that once again players only compete in singles and can schedule matches around their other darting committments.

Though the league is national, the local players will comprise the local league play.

You must sign-up by January 27 and matches will begin the beginning of Febuary. Your money will be refunded after three months if you are not "completely satisfied" and a free subsciption of Bulls Eye News magazine is included with membership.

Every six months a \$1,000 tournament open to members only will be played with free entry. This will be a doubles tournament with the number 1

ranked player being paired with the last ranked player, eg: #1 & #64, #2 & #63, #3 & #62, etc. This will allow a fair chance for all participating members to win.


***** D.D.A. MEMBERSHIP CARDS *****

The Activity Period is designed to present a wide variety of activities for student participation Each school offers approximately 30 different activities. Activities available include: sports-oriented interests such as Basketball and Table Tennis; intellectual pursuits such as Young Authors and Chess; hobby interests such as Photography and Stitchery; and clubs covering diverse interests such as Travel and Sister Cities. Clubs may be offered all year long or on a six-week basis. Students register for the activity of their choice prior to the start of a new activity session. Following is an excerpt of an editorial written by CARL STRAVINSKI and published in the D.D.A. Newsletter December 1983. With complaints of unsportsman like behavior this article was chosen to be rerun.

"Any competition involving skills, techniques, finesse agility, mobility, strength, reasoning, etc., requires a well adjusted mental attitude and a certain stability of composure. Courtesies are paramount in any living situation and, without doubt, darts is a living situation. A maladjusted mental attitude in a discourteous situation can be frustrating and embarrassing.

Your Editor has been involved in a wide variety of athletic competition for over 40 years as competitor, supervisor and coach, and is well aware of the mental and emotional stresses involved in the struggle to become a winner. The crescendo of a verbose opponent and the poor performance a darter overtaxes the mental and emotional capacity to the breaking point. The built up stresses may result in a vocal and/or physical outburst. This is unfortunate. Isn't it strange----, you never see or hear of a winner become the instigator of a physical confrontation.

So we deal with a person in a losing cause. Next time you shoot take notice of a loser. You will be able to classify losers as 1) good; 2) dumbfounded; 3) sulking; and 4) poor. The good loser is the guy who is always complimenting his opponent on his shot and especially after the match is over.

The dumbfounded loser is the one, usually considered a better shooter, who looks dazed, and is amazed, after losing to what is considered an inferior opponent. If there is any verbal reaction, it is a muffled congratulatory remark.

The sulker just puts his tail between his legs, does an about face to the rear of the pub, or leaves pronto without any remarks.

The poor loser---. Well, this is what this bit of verbage is all about. I don't think an explanation is required.

If you lose, BE A GOOD LOSER. It is not degrading to lose a tight match. You did your best. That's what counts. A poorly played match is the result of your poor execution and only YOU CAN TAKE THE RESPONSIBILITY. Do not take it out on your opponent.

I ask all darters to read this article again and rationalize your darting mental and emotional stability. Someone has to lose. It may be difficult but you can be a good loser."

*** ORDER OF PLAY ***

A question concerning the order of play at D.D.A. league matches was recently raised.

The response was: play shall follow the order set forth on the scoresheet with each set of games (Cricket Doubles, 301 Doubles, 501 Singles and Cricket Singles) being played two (2) at a time, one (1) game per board. However, if BOTH team captains agree, the order of play may be altered. Examples being; play a Singles game on an open board while a 301 Doubles game is still in progress, or play the last Singles game first.

The underlying fact is that BOTH team captains MUST agree to the changes. If BOTH captains do not agree, play shall follow the order set forth on the scoresheet.

Reports are being given to the Board that foul language is being used at matches as well as childish behavior. This cannot be tolerated in that the actions of a certain few damage the image of the league, the majority of our Members and darts as a whole.

Unsportsmanlike behavior will be dealt with accordingly. The Rules For League Play and The By Laws allow the Board to issue disciplinary action if warranted. Use of abusive language, disrupting of matches, hitting of walls, throwing your darts against wall or table, etc. are considered childish to say the least and most definetely unsportsmanlike. Reports should be filed via the grievence forms (available by request) and severe cases by the protest procedure descibed in the Rules For League Play 1988-89.

***** LUCKY SIXTEEN ****

Several Lucky 16 dart leagues operate in the Dayton area. These offer round robin play of 301, 501 or cricket. The matches encompass singles matches and definitly improve one's game, most notably out shots. Trips to major dart tournaments and/or cash awards are awarded to top point holders at timed intervals. 
