## CFA Certified Fire Officer IV

*This course is being offered through the Fairfield Regional Fire School but will be taught and tested by Connecticut Fire Academy Instructors.*

This semi-independent study course consists of a balance of regularly scheduled peer group discussion sessions and the development of individual projects. Areas covered in the discussions and projects will focus heavily on human resource management, administration, multi-agency emergency services delivery and safety. Oriented to the level of Assistant Chief, Deputy Chief or Chief, topics covered in this course include: grievance administration, training and educational goal setting and planning, employee assistance programs, incentive programs, community event planning, long-range planning, and civil disturbance and disaster planning.
