Dear Veterans and Friends,

As always, we had a wonderful Saint Patrick's Day Dinner with over 30 members and guests in attendance. A big thanks to Danny Cipollitti and family for preparing and serving the meal and to the members and auxiliary for decorating, setting up, and cleaning up.

Also, a big thanks to Ed Jackson for kicking off our Military Lecture Series. Ed gave a very informative and entertaining presentation on the Civil War 1st Artillery Regiment Battery M. One member in attendance had a great-grandfather who served with the unit and was wounded in battle. Please let me know if you or any friends would be interested in making a presentation at our future lecture events.

Old Fort Niagara will be holding a two-day Patriots Day event on April 18 and 19 featuring reenactors from Hosington's New York Rangers, Brant's Volunteers, and the 26th Regiment Afoot. Activities run from 10:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. and are free to active duty military and veterans.

We received great news from the Village of Youngstown on the repairs to the Veterans Memorial. The Lewiston-Porter schools collected \$2,800 from the sale of wrist bands and this was matched by a donation of \$2,500 from the Lewiston Kiwanis Club. The Village has also received over \$2,000 in personal and business donations. These donations will cover the cost of damage to the memorial and any extra funds will be put in an account to maintain the memorial.

If you are tired of returning your empty cans and bottles, you can now drop them off at the Porter Empty Return Center in Ransomville and donate your returns to Post 313. I have set-up an account where the Post will receive 5 cents on every return and the Return Center will give us an extra 5 percent on top. Porter Empty Return Center is across the street from Crosby's/Dunkin Donuts. When you drop off your returns, tell them you want to donate them to VFW Post 313. You can also drop your bottle and cans off at the Post and we will take care of the recycling.

We have many activities coming up in the next two months, including the nomination and election of officers, Post clean-up, poppy donations, Memorial Day Ceremony, and many community events in honor of our veterans. We will be looking for volunteers to help with the clean-up, poppy donations, and to serve as officers in the Post.
