



## FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Skiing can be an expensive sport, and BART feels strongly about providing financial assistance to those who need it! We do not want finances to be a prohibitive factor in the enrollment of a child into BART.

We have financial grants, or scholarships, available to families of BART. It is required that financial grant applications be filled out upon the due date (postdated or delivered on that date). The grant form has been included in this package.

The grant application just requires the filling out of one page. In addition, short and simple essays from each child needing financial assistance, and one from a parent per family are required (instructions for all of this are included on the form).

We have a third-party grant committee that determines exactly which applicants will receive the designated amounts of money so there will be no biases from board members or coaches.

If you are applying for a scholarship your \$100 deposit is due when you turn in your registration paperwork however, your 1<sup>st</sup> payment will be deferred until your possible scholarships are awarded so we know your balance due.

It is a very straightforward process, so please do NOT hesitate to contact any of us if you have ANY questions!

You also have the option of making smaller payments throughout the season if you feel as if that is an option. These scheduling arrangements can be agreed upon by the Program Director, Trevor Tyas, and the family ahead of time.
