

Criteria for qualifying for discounted rounds and/or ammo.

1. Volunteer for the club

- 1.1. All members are required to volunteer for the club. Shooters will not be able to receive discounted rounds and/or ammo until they have volunteered. Events to volunteer at include, but are not limited to, annual fundraiser at beginning of academic year, Texas A&M Trap and Skeet hosted shoots, and/or range clean up days.
- 1.2. Volunteering is considered arriving at beginning of event and leaving after closing of event.
- 1.3. Should the member be unable to volunteer due to an extreme conflict, an email must be sent to a current officer. All current officers will make a unanimous agreement on the legitimacy of the excuse.

2. Must attend at least two practices before receiving discounted rounds/shells. Practices must occur in separate weeks.

- 2.1. Qualifying practice for Discounted Rounds and/or ammo requires the following:
 - 2.1.1. Must attend two non-consecutive practices. Discounted rounds and/or ammo will be allowed at the following practice after the member's 2nd qualifying practice.
 - 2.1.2. Signing in to the practice sign-in sheet for qualifying and non-qualifying practices.
 - 2.1.3. Practice is considered completing at least (2) full rounds of any shooting event open at practice. This includes but is not limited to American Trap, American Skeet, International Trap, and International Skeet.

3. Dues paid in full

- 3.1. Other criteria may be met however member will not receive discounted rounds and/or ammo, nor be allowed to participate in any club events, including practice, until they have paid their dues in full.

4. All appropriate member paperwork completely filled out and turned in

- 4.1. This includes, but is not limited to, driver agreements, safety forms, rec sports club liability forms, shooting range waiver form, etc.
- 4.2. Other criteria may be met however member will not receive discounted rounds and/or ammo, nor be allowed to participate in any club events, including practice, until they have completed all paperwork deemed necessary by current club officers, coaches, and rec sports staff.

5. Hold positive standing with University and Club

- 5.1. Members without a good academic standing with the University will not be allowed discounted rounds and/or ammo.
- 5.2. Members who have been deemed unsafe by club officers and/or the majority or participating club members will not be allowed discounted rounds and/or ammo.
- 5.3. Other criteria may be met however member will not receive discounted rounds and/or ammo, nor be allowed to participate in any club events, including practice, until they obtain a positive standing with Texas A&M University and the Texas A&M Trap and Skeet Club.

Criteria 3, 4, and 5 must all be met before any member is allowed to practice at the Boswell Porter 4-H Range. All of the above criteria must be met before any member is eligible for discounted rounds and/or ammo.

Disclaimer:

Any criteria not listed above may be considered illegitimate. The current officer cabinet reserve the right to make amendments to the criteria listed above but not without the announcement of the changes to the club. Any member who has completed all (5) criteria prior to any amendment automatically completes any added criteria. Any member who has not yet completed all (5) criteria prior to any amendment must meet all listed criteria, original and new, in order to be eligible for discounted rounds and/or ammo. The current officer cabinet reserves the right to deny eligibility to any club member and amend the discounted price members must pay for rounds and/or ammo. Texas A&M Trap and Skeet is not required by any Texas A&M University code or regulation to offer a discounted price for ammo or rounds.
