

HACIENDA LA FLOR DE MORELOS IN PLANO OPENED IN NOVEMBER OF 2018



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Hacienda La Flor de Morelos located at 212 Mitchell Drive in Plano (630/882-9528, located in the strip center just north of the new Illinois DMV office) was named by owner Lourdes Ruiz for the beautiful state of Morelos in Mexico where she lived before coming to the United States.

The menu features authentic Mexican food including Tacos with Steak, Chicken, Ground Beef, Al Pastor, Chorizo (Mexican sausage), Chile Relleno, Chicharron, Lengua, Tripa, and an Alambre version with steak, bacon, grilled green peppers & onions and cheese. Toppings which can be added include cilantro, onions, lettuce, tomato, sour cream, cheese, avocado, guacamole and pico,

Al a Carte items are Burritos, Burrito Suizo, Chimichangas, Tostadas, Gorditas, and Sopes with all the above listed items; plus Flautas (with choice of potato, chicken, lettuce, tomatoes and sour cream); Quesadillas (with meat); Nacho Platters; Taco Salads; Tortas; Morelos Platters & Bowls and Alambre Pizza.

Dinners are served with rice, beans and tortillas, with either Tacos, Burritos, Chimichangas, Tostadas, Gorditas, Sopes, Quesadillas, or Fajitas. Other entrees include Carne Asada, Tampiquena, Bistec a la Mexicana, Chile Relleno and Chicharron.



Side orders of Rice; Beans; Salsa, Guacamole or Pico & Chips; Avocado, Green, Red or Habanero Salsa; Jalapenos & Carrots or Chile Toreados are all available.

Tamales in either half dozen or full dozen portions can be ordered with either pork or chicken.

For Vegetarian diners, options include beans, rice, lettuce, tomatoes and avocados. Caldos (soup), served with cilantro, onions, lime and tortillas, come in 32 oz, ½ gallon and gallon sizes. Seasonal choices are Caldo de Res (beef and vegetable stew) and Caldo de Pollo (chicken and vegetable stew). Pozole (hominy) and Caldo

de Albondigas (meatball) soups are always on the menu.

Desserts feature Arroz Con Leche (rice pudding), Fried Ice Cream, Churros and Flan.

Breakfast items served all day during open hours include Breakfast Burritos with eggs, potatoes and cheese and choice of chorizo, bacon, ham or veggies; Chilequilles con Huevo or meat, with tortillas chips, eggs, side of rice & beans; Huevos a la Mexicana (eggs, green peppers, onions, tomatoes, jalapenos, & beans); Huevos Rancheros (tostadas, eggs, salsa & beans); and Huevos Chorizo Y Papas (eggs, chorizo & potatoes). Hacienda Restaurant has a full service bar.

The next Cruise Nights take place Saturday, August 17th from 4 – 9 PM for import cars and Wednesday, September 11th from 5:30 to 8:30 PM. All years and wheels are welcome! There will be specials, music and prizes

Mexican Salsa Dancing is held from 9 PM to 2 AM every Saturday night with a DJ. Thursday nights feature a Mariachi band. Future plans include a volleyball court behind the restaurant.

There is ample parking in a lot in front of the restaurant.

Hours of operation are Tuesday & Wednesday, 11 AM to 9 PM; Thursday – Saturday, 11 AM to 10 PM; Sunday, 11 AM to 8 PM; Closed Monday.
