



This information sheet will provide you with information on the steps you need to complete to sell permitted **NONAERIAL COMMON FIREWORKS** within the Middleton Rural Fire District and Star Fire Protection District.

If you are operating a stand within the city limits of Middleton or Star additional applications are required by each city. It is the responsibly of the Owner/Operator make contact with the city and complete all required applications prior to the deadline below.

Fees must be paid in the form of check or money order in the amount of \$50.00 payable to the Fire District having jurisdiction. The fee includes permit and initial inspection.

Inspection scheduling shall be coordinated through the Fire Code Official (208) 585-6650. Inspections may be performed Monday through Friday between 8am and 5pm.

All Temporary Firework Stands are subject to the approval of the Fire Code Official once they are set up. Stands must meet all of the criteria listed on the Inspection Form before a permit will be issued. The Fire Code Official will present the Owner/Operator with copies of the inspection and permits from the city in which the stand is operating.

All Permit must be posted conspicuously inside the stand during all hours of operation.

Compliance inspections may be performed at random times and without notice. Fire Code Official may or may not be in uniform and may or may not be utilizing an official vehicle. Stands found to be not in compliance will have their permit revoked on scene by the Inspector. Stands with revoked permits must immediately cease operations and sales. The Fire Code Official or his/her designee may re-issue the permit, at their discretion; after all unsatisfactory items are resolved.

No temporary fireworks stand used during the summer sales period shall be erected before June 15. The premises on which such temporary fireworks stand is erected shall be cleared of any and all temporary fireworks stands and debris not later than twelve o'clock (12:00) noon on July 12. No temporary fireworks stand used during the winter sales period shall be erected before December 15. The premises on which such temporary fireworks stand is erected shall be cleared of any and all temporary fireworks stands and debris not later than twelve o'clock (12:00) noon on January 8.

Nonaerial common fireworks, special fireworks, and fireworks may be sold at retail and used beginning at twelve o'clock (12:00) midnight June 23 an ending at twelve o'clock (12:00) midnight July 5, and beginning at twelve o'clock (12:00) midnight December 26 and ending at twelve o'clock (12:00) midnight January 1 each year. The use of fireworks must also comply with the city noise ordinances.

	Must be at least 25 ft away from any sources and/or their fuels.	Must be at least 25 ft away from any other building or structure and from any generator or other internal combustion power ources and/or their fuels.					
	The stand must be at least 25 feet away from any other building or structure.						
	The stand must be at least 100 feet away from any fuel storage/dispensing station.						
	No temporary fireworks stand shall have a floor area in excess of seven hundred (700) square feet.						
	Stand must meet the 2018 International Fire Code requirements for temporary and permanent tents and membrane structures. (International Fire Code, Chapter 31, Section 3104 and all subsections)						
	Any and all temporary fireworks stands shall have exit doors at least thirty inches (30") wide at both ends of the temporary fireworks stand and one additional door for each thirty-two feet (32') of rear wall in excess of thirty-two feet (32'). All doors shall open outward from the temporary fireworks stand and all doorways shall be kept clear and operational at all times. No operator shall cause or allow any exit from a temporary fireworks stand to be obstructed, unopenable, inaccessible, or malfunctioning.						
	Each stand/tent shall be provided with a minimum of one (1) type 2A10BC rated fire extinguisher, and one (1) 2A water type fire extinguisher in good working order and with a current inspection tag in place dated within the last calendar year. Extinguishers must be hung three to four feet above the floor. Extinguishers must be readily visible and accessible at all times.

	There shall be NO short-term storage within 25' of fireworks stand/tent. The storage container must be less than 320 square feet and be located at least 25' from any building or structure. Must have a 2A fire extinguisher located within 48" of the door and be at a height of three to four feet.
	At least one sign reading, "No Fireworks To Be Discharged Within 100 Feet" in letters at least four inches (4") high on a contrasting background shall be posted on each and every exterior wall or side of any and all temporary fireworks stands. Such signs shall be maintained in a legible condition at all times.
	Prior to erecting any temporary fireworks stand, and throughout the applicable sales period, the ground underlying such temporary fireworks stand and all ground within a thirty-foot (30') perimeter thereof shall be cleared and maintained clear of any and all weeds, combustible vegetation or material, and/or debris. No operator shall permit the accumulation of rubbish or trash in or around any temporary fireworks stand. No operator shall permit a fire nuisance or hazard to exist in or around any temporary fireworks stand.
	All stands shall be 25' from any generator or internal combustion engine and vehicle parking.
	All permits are required to be posted in the stand at all times.
	Allowed to be erected (2) two temporary signs not to exceed 32 square feet each. The posting of these signs shall not obscure vehicles line of sight.
	One additional sign may be erected and affixed to the stand. Sign not to exceed 32 square feet.
	Any and all temporary fireworks stands shall be emptied of all fireworks when not open for business. This provision shall not apply where the operation is not open for business and the temporary fireworks stand is used as a short term storage facility

	The Temporary Stand listed in this document has passed the Fire & Life Safety Inspection for compliance. The Fire Code Officials signature signs off on the inspection and recommends to the City/County/State that permits and/or licenses be issued.
	The Temporary Stand listed in this document has NOT passed the Fire & Life Safety Inspection for compliance. The Fire Code Officials signature recommends to the City/County/State that permits and/or licenses NOT be issued until all documented violations are corrected.
