## Save the Date for Beach Cleanup at Barber Tract

BTNA President Dave Talcott spent Saturday September 16, 2017 from 9:00-Noon with the "I Love a Clean San Diego" team at La Jolla Shores. Due to many events scheduled at Windansea this year, the city did not approve another Coastal Cleanup in La Jolla. Instead, La Jolla Shores is where the team picked up over 80 pounds of trash and recyclables.

David joined in the La Jolla Shores site as Co-Captain with Barbara Bry, our District 1 Council Member.

While the overall totals are still being tabulated as of press time, there were preliminary totals of 6,500 volunteers, over 120,000 pounds of trash collected and over 5,000 pounds of recyclables.

He and Mike Cole, the Co-Captain for La Jolla Windansea will head back to Barber Tract area in April for the annual "Creek to Bay Cleanup".
