

Bubby Bags

What do you do when your dog becomes lost? You may have already had your dog microchipped, but what if the dog is not caught? These bags will help the tracking dogs have a strong scent to follow and hopefully have your dog home to you as soon as possible.

Things you will need: Rubber gloves, sealable plastic bag, clean cloth, scissors

- 1) First, put on the gloves and take a clipping of your dogs hair. Then rub the cloth all over your dog.
- 2) Place the cloth and the hair clipping into the plastic bag. Label the bag with the day's date and the dog's name.
- 3) Place the labelled bag in the freezer.

If your dog goes missing, you can use the bag to have a fresh scent for the tracking dogs. Update each dog's Bubby Bag every year to ensure a strong scent.

These bags can also be used by breeders placing dogs and new puppies, shelters/rescues with their adoptables, and given to handlers, dog sitters, boarding kennels, etc.

These should always be a part of your emergency kit in case the unthinkable happens.
