Important Vendor Information for Cromwell Festival 2023

- Set Up Instructions will be sent only through email, prior to the festival.
- The Cromwell Festival is an outdoor event. Vendors are mapped outside and will want to plan accordingly for the weather.
- There are electric and water restrictions for Friday at Cromwell Park. We do not have access to 220 Electric and only a select number of 110 hookups and water hookups will be available. These will be given in the order applications are received. We will contact you if we are unable to accommodate your electric/water requests for Friday evening.
- There are no electric or water restrictions for Saturday Uptown Cromwell.
- Vendors are able to set up the night before, at their own risk. There will not be overnight security.
- All Food Vendors Must Have a Noble County Health Department Permit: Health Department Phone # 260-636-2191.
- The Festival Committee works diligently not to duplicate vendors and to maintain a variety of food and craft options. Register early to guarantee a position.
- The Festival Committee offers vendor positions to recurring vendors for a minimum of 1 week prior to opening the application window to all other vendors. This allows us to maintain a healthy working relationship with vendors each year.
- The Festival Committee and/or the Town of Cromwell are not responsible for any damages that occur unless done so by a committee member or Town of Cromwell employee.
- We do not refund vendor application fees if the vendor chooses to cancel. We will refund vendor application fees if the committee cancels the event or vendor. Refunds will be in the form of a check to the business or name on the vendor application.
- We are happy to provide a schedule of events sent to your email upon request. Alternatively, a paper schedule is also available at the information booth.
- Winners of certain festival events will receive 'Cromwell Bucks'. A member of the festival committee
 will let you know what the 'Cromwell Bucks' look like and we ask that you treat them as cash during
 the festival. Periodically, a member of the festival committee will move through the booths and trade
 out the 'Cromwell Bucks' for cash.
- The festival committee works hard to put on a successful event for the vendors and participants. We encourage your feedback regarding your vendor experience and may send out a survey to vendors after the festival to help us improve for the next year.
