FULL-TIME POLICE OFFICER POSITION

The City of Silver Bay, located on the North Shore of Lake Superior, is accepting applications for the position of Full-Time Police Officer within the Police Department. The primary function is to patrol city streets, enforce laws and ordinances, and conduct investigations. All applicants must provide a copy of their current Minnesota P.O.S.T. license with the application, a copy of their Minnesota P.O.S.T. eligibility letter, or at minimum be P.O.S.T. eligible at the time of appointment. A comprehensive background investigation with medical and psychological examinations is required as a condition of employment. This is for a full-time position with competitive wages and benefits. The 2021 full pay rate is \$24.50 - \$30.62/hour, depending upon qualifications and experience, with full pay rate achievable within one year. The 2022 full pay rate is \$31.12/hour. FULL-TIME PROGRAM DIRECTOR
