

ELDON CARL STING

1921 - 1979

Eldon C. Sting, age 58 of Pigeon, passed away Sunday, Dec. 30 at Saginaw Community Hospital, Saginaw.

He was born Sept. 18, 1921 in Pigeon, the son of Carl and Mamie Sting. On Oct. 22, 1949, he was united in marriage to Dorothy B. Shar-rard in Pigeon.
