What is PRIDE?

PRIDE is a PTA-run program offering PRES students a wide variety of enrichment classes, allowing them to explore their specific interests. Classes take place immediately after school and require a 4:20pm pick up at PRES. All classes take place at PRES.

Please Note

PRIDE classes begin 10/7/19

Children are dismissed to the gym at 3:00, where they are checked in by PTA volunteers and met by their PRIDE instructor. PRIDE classes conclude at 4:20, at which time PRIDE instructors return children to the cafeteria. Please pick up your child from the cafeteria at 4:20. You will incur a late fee for pick-ups after 4:30.

Cancellations

PRIDE sessions follow the same schedule as the Bedford Central School District regarding holidays, school closings and delays due to inclement weather or un-planned events. If a class is cancelled a make-up will be held at the end of the session. A PRIDE member will contact you when the make-up has been scheduled.

Discipline

All PRIDE students are expected to follow the PRES CARE Code of Conduct during their PRIDE classes. If a child does not behave, it becomes a distraction to the other students and diminishes the quality of the class. Please inform your child that appropriate behavior is expected of him or her during all phases of the PRIDE sessions.
