Special thank you to SSI Rotary, TT Foundation, Nancy Muldowney, Ann Marie Dalis, and the Boy Scouts.

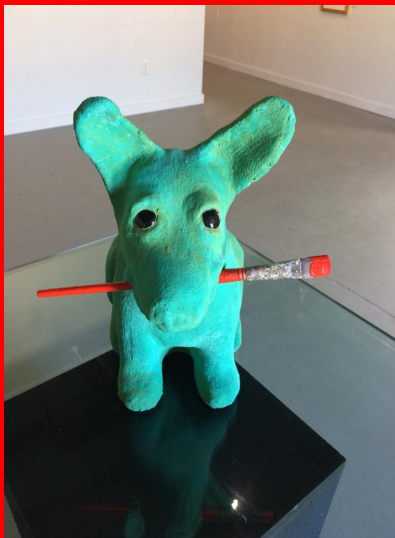
We couldn't have done it without you!
