

RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE USE OF RESERVOIRS WITHIN FORT BEND COUNTY  
MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 42  
(Exhibit "D" from the District's Resolution adopted August, 1997)

1. No motorized boats, other than electric powered boats that do not exceed eleven feet (11') in length and four feet (4') in width and that do not have more than one motor not exceeding two horsepower, shall be allowed in the Reservoirs.
2. Remote controlled boats less than forty-eight inches (48") in length shall be allowed in the Reservoirs.
3. Sailboats, paddle boats and canoes shall be allowed in the Reservoirs provided that they do not exceed fourteen feet (14') in length and six feet (6') in width.
4. No boats shall be left unattended.
5. No boats of any nature may be launched or removed from the Reservoirs in any manner that would violate any of the Brightwater Homeowners Association's deed restrictions.
6. No swimming or wading shall be allowed in the Reservoirs.
7. No one (even property owners owning land adjacent to the Reservoirs) may construct boat docks or other structures that extend into the Reservoirs, except the Brightwater Homeowners Association which may construct facilities on its property with prior written consent from the District.
8. There shall be no dumping of any trash or other substances in the Reservoirs.
9. There shall be no dangerous activities conducted on or within thirty (30) feet of the Reservoirs.
10. There shall be no floating boat docks or other similar structures constructed within the Reservoirs.
11. There shall be no use of the Reservoirs between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.
12. Netting of fish or other aquatic life is prohibited.
13. All fishing lines must be attached to a fishing pole.
14. Any person fishing in the Reservoirs must have a valid fishing license.
15. The rules and regulations of the State of Texas shall govern the size and number of fish to be taken.
16. Unattended fishing poles are prohibited.
17. The feeding, harassment, catching or killing of alligators is prohibited.

18. No construction, filling or dredging shall be allowed within the boundaries of the Reservoirs.

19. No person under the age of 13 shall be allowed in the Reservoirs or in boats or other water-borne crafts in the Reservoirs unless under the direct supervision of an adult guardian or natural adult parent.

Any violation of these rules shall subject the violator to a penalty not to exceed Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000) for each violation. Each day that a violation of any of these rules hereof continues shall be considered a separate violation.
