

## Dessie Shows Tolbert

Services for Mrs. Dessie Shows Tolbert, 82, former resident of Oil City, were held at 10 a.m. Saturday, June 11 at Rose-Neath's Marshall Street Chapel. Officiating was Rev. Ron Finical, pastor of United Pentecostal Church of Oil City. Burial followed in Lakeview Memorial Gardens in Oil City.
