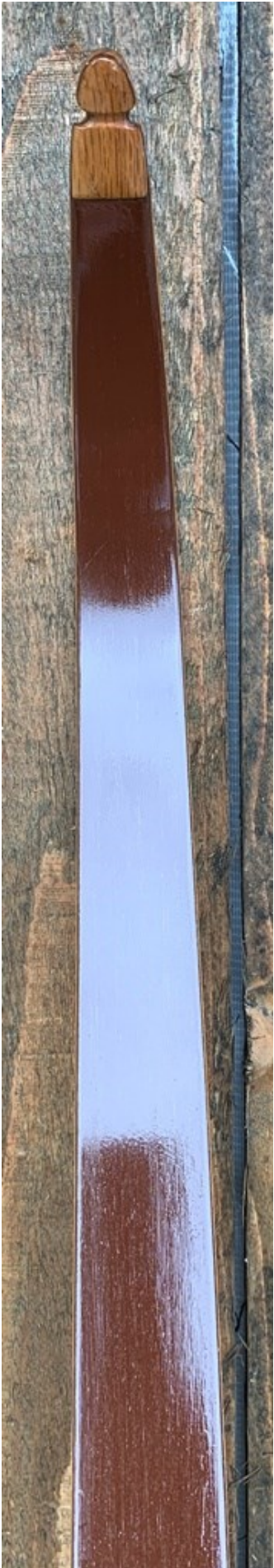

DESCRIPTION: Great looking and performing recurve. The Hunter 709 has features found in higher-end bows, such as a beveled bow shelf, dual-sided tip overlays, and desirable Zebra-wood riser material. It has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. Two small professionally filled drilled holes on the back of the bow (see pic). No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches and scuffs here and there. Decal is in near mint condition. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age.
