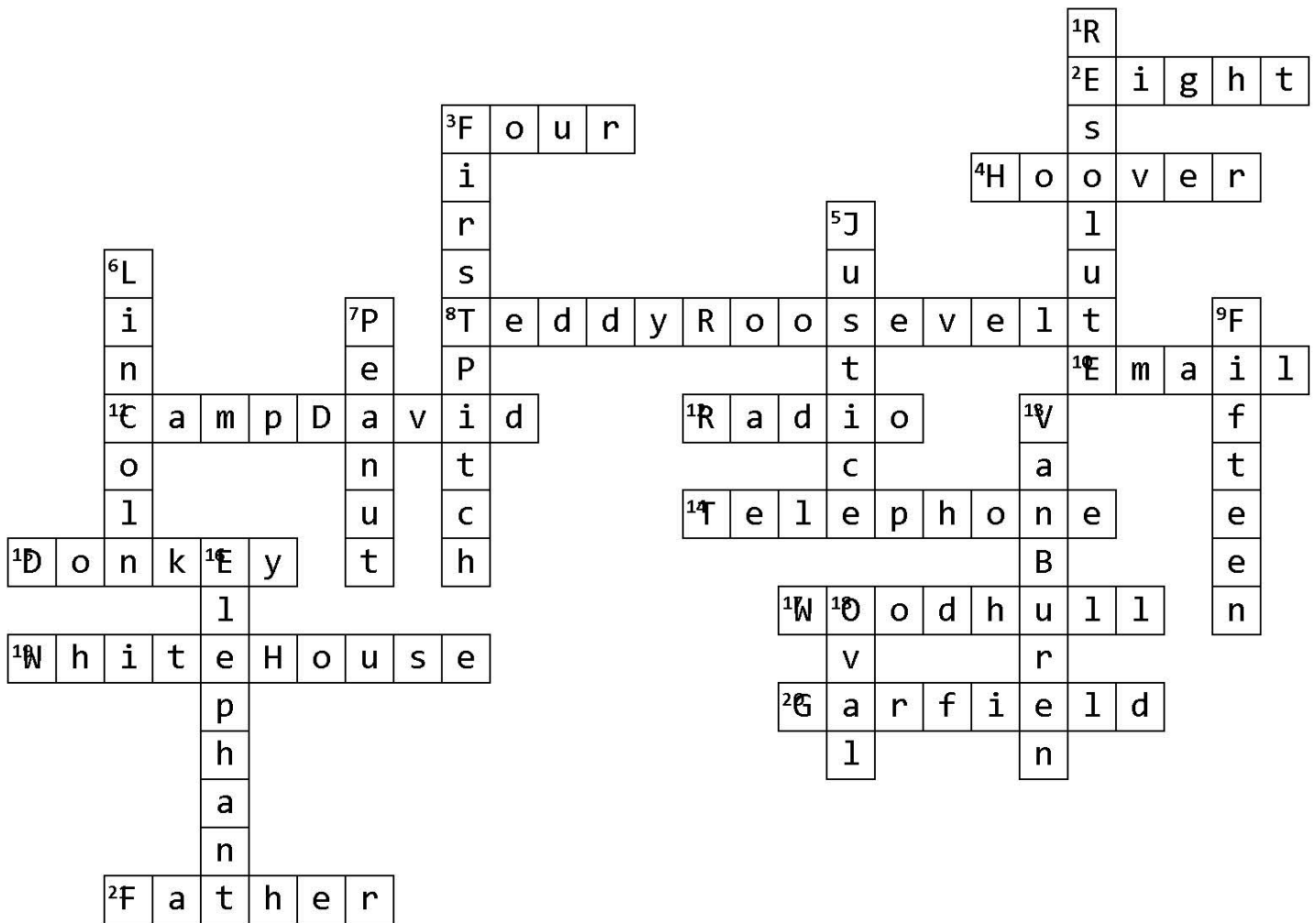


Presidential Puzzle
