## Communion of Saints

This week there will be several saintly celebrations in our liturgical calendar for us to celebrate and appreciate.

**Monday October 1 is a memorial for St. Therese of Lisieux (the little flower) of the Child Jesus.** I will be with my parents that day. St Therese is my favorite saint and I will take my Mass kit and have a Mass with my parents at their place. My mom has a strong devotion to the Little Flower as well. She asks St. Therese to pray that her flowers will grow well especially the roses and it always seems to happen. St. Therese was declared a saint on May 17, 1925. May 17 happens to be my birthday but not in 1925! My maternal grandma was born on Oct. 1, St. Therese's feast day. My dad was born on July 13, which is the same date Saints Louis and Zelle (first husband and wife saints) were married (St. Therese's parents). My niece Lexi was born on January 2, which is the same date St. Therese was born. Now you see important dates that pertain to St. Therese that correspond to dates in my family's life. This is one of the reasons she is my favorite saint.

**Tuesday October 2 is a memorial for our Guardian Angels.** They are not make believe. We are all assigned a guardian angel when we are born to protect and guide us. Do you remember the Guardian angel prayer? - In case you forgot, it goes like this--**"Angel of God, my guardian dear, to whom His love commits me here- Ever this day- Be at my side, to light and guard and rule and guide."**

We recently had the feast day of the Archangels Saints Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael. Some of you may wonder how angels can be saints when they are only spirits and have no bodies. The word 'saint' means holy and the angels are certainly holy.

**Thursday October 4 is the obligatory memorial for St. Francis of Assisi.** He is one of the "super" saints meaning he is well known among the faithful. Did you know that St. Francis never rose above deacon status because he did not think he was worthy to become a priest? Also, St Francis did not write the so called "Prayer of St. Francis" ("Make me a channel of your peace.") but he most certainly lived the prayer that was attributed to him. St. Francis was also known to love God's creation including animals. It is a tradition in our faith to bless animals on this date and we will be doing it at both parishes at the following times:

**1:30 p.m. in front of the old St. Joseph school building**

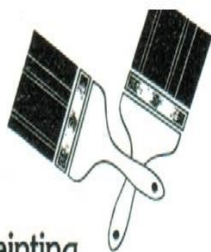
