### **Application instructions and requirements**

- Complete and submit application by April 1, 2017. Late or incomplete applications **will not** be accepted.
- A completed application will include **this form, an essay, an official transcript including GPA and SAT Scores, college/university acceptance letter, and three (3) letters of recommendation on official letterhead from a teacher, guidance counselor and or headmaster. One of the three letters of recommendation may be from a member of the clergy or an employer.**
- **Applicant must be a US citizen.**
- Upon reasonable notice, applicant agrees to make him/herself available for a personal interview.
- Applicant must be a senior in a public or private high school in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and planning to attend a two or four year accredited college/university in the fall of 2017. **Scholarship awards are not renewable.**
- Application and supporting **documents must be typed** or printed legibly.
- Applications must be mailed to the above address and postmarked **no later than April 1, 2017.**
- If selected the applicant must make a commitment to be present at the public ceremony hosted by BEAM in **June 2017.**
