## SAFETY ORTS:

#### Guns and Pets:

In November, a 74-year-old New Mexico man was shot in the torso by his dog. He left his loaded gun on the back seat while on a rabbit hunting trip with his three dogs. One of the dogs jumped up on the seat and accidentally pulled the trigger, shooting the man through the driver's seat. He suffered three broken ribs and a punctured lung. In December, a former LSU football player was out duck hunting and laid his loaded gun on the bed of their Polaris Ranger. One of the dogs jumped up in the bed of the Ranger and managed to dislodge the safety and pull the trigger, shooting the man in the leg. The man ended up having his leg amputated. Please be mindful of gun safety when your pets are around to avoid tragedy.

#### Ammo requirements:

Steel core bullets are not allowed. These bullets may cause damage to the backstop. How do you know if your bullets are steel core? Keep a magnet in your range bag and run it over the bullets. If the magnet sticks, don't shoot it at TPPC. You will typically see this in Chinese and Russian ammo brands.

Also, remember that .22 magnum is not allowed. These rounds exceed range velocity requirements and will cause damage to the backstop.

#### Safety refresher class:

Until you attend a safety refresher class, you will NOT be allowed to renew. Because of the safety class requirement, renewals will no longer be accepted by mail. You can come to a regular meeting and attend the new member class afterwards to meet the requirement. After attending the class, you will be allowed to renew your membership.
