With the great time we had at the Mini-Growl during the Midwinter Conference and less than five months to go, I am excited to see what Oklahoma will hold for us as we once again gather for a milestone event in our shared history. From everything I hear,

things are shaping up nicely and it should be a great time for the MODD in OK. Surprisingly, with this milestone convention we are running behind what we normally see in Applications for Degree Advancement by now. Pound and Pack Dog Robbers please do not sit on the applications, send them in as soon as possible, they must be in the Kennel Dog Robber's paws by July



1st or the Dog will not be able to advance. Individual Dogs, Pound and Pack staff may verify receipt and processing of advancement forms on the Kennel home page, just scroll down and click on "2023 Supreme Growl" and from there you should be able to locate the list of applications which have been processed. If it has been a couple weeks and it is not there check back with the Pound Dog Robber and follow up.

Barking of the Kennel web site, we have our first online raffle in process which you may access from the home page. This raffle will close on April 30th, please help support the MODD by purchasing raffle tickets and spreading the word. Keep checking back as we plan

to put up a new raffle item shortly after each drawing. Your participation and support are greatly appreciated, good luck to all who enter!

The Honorable Dog Robber and her deputies working along with the Honorable Executive Director were able to make significant progress at Midwinter on rosters and assisting Pounds and Packs with EIN and 990 issues. As previously reported, Honorable Deputy Dog Robber PDD Steve Seyller now has a more focused role as the Honorable Deputy Dog Robber (Compliance) and is there to assist Pounds and Packs with EIN, 990 and other compliance issues. Additionally, Division Vice Chief Devil Dogs, Pack Leaders, etc.... it might prove useful to bark with PDD Seyller about setting up a Zoom or other virtual meeting/training with PDD Seyller and all of your Dog Robbers.

BIG BARKS to those who have brought their Pound or Pack into compliance and those making headway on compliance issues and communicating with your Division Vice Chief Devil Dogs, keep it up - Woof, Woof!

One of my enjoyable duties as Chief has been approving requests for advancement to Pedigreed Devil Dog for those Pups and Devil Dogs qualifying under the Medical Exceptions allowance in the bylaws for those with failing health. Those approved may be advanced to Pedigreed Devil Dog without having to attend a Supreme Growl. There have been issues with some coming in under the medical exception rule. The normal advancement application



is to be submitted along with a written request from the Pound with an approval endorsement from the Pack accompanied by a statement from competent medical authority specifically addressing the condition of the individual for whom the exemption is being sought. The types of problems which have led to some of these being sent back without approval are:


- No advancement application.
- No written request from the Pound.
- Request from Pound doesn't include Pack endorsement.
- Medical condition is temporary in nature.
- Letter addressing condition not from competent medical authority.

A couple of the above problems are pretty obvious and could be easily fixed. The ones that get a little more complicated are, medical condition is temporary in nature vice failing health. A statement saying the individual had some sort of serious surgery, doesn't necessarily tell us the surgery has created a permanent reason the individual won't be able to travel to, or participate at a future Supreme Growl following recovery, as others have done. One statement said, "... has an unusual ocular problem, please help him." We've had others go through the initiation with serious vision problems and we can have someone help them if needed. There have been a number of letters which were signed off by someone with an MSW which is a Masters in Social Work, not a medical degree or indicative of any medical training and one which appeared to be signed by someone on the office staff. For the medical exception letter, it needs to identify the problem in basic terms and state that there is no reason to expect the condition to improve to the point the individual would be able to participate in the future. Sadly, we have not seen any of the ones with easy fixes, like the Pack endorsement, resubmitted

for approval. Please look over the requirements in the by-laws before submitting these packages for medical exceptions. These are covered in Article I – Membership, Section 101 – Eligibility.

Many thanks for the great hospitality at the conferences I have attended so far, many of you are setting new benchmarks. WOOF, WOOF to all of you sending in lots of Big Bones for the Children's Hospital Donation in Oklahoma City, great work Dogs!

To the Division Vice Chief Devil Dogs PLEASE work on your Renewals. The Order suffered a big hit with the onset of COVID. There are many Dogs that have not paid their dues since their Pounds were not holding Growls. Many of those Dogs still have not paid even though their Pounds have resumed holding Growls. The Division Vice Chief that makes the biggest change in their delinquency will be recognized at the 83rd Supreme Growl.

Operation Chow Hound is spreading across the Country. We now have an official Logo for the Program and the Kennel will has a Fillable PDF online so a record can be kept on the amount of Dog Chow donated. 

The deadline for submission of proposed changes to the Kennel Bylaws was 15 MAR 2023. We have five Proposed Bylaws Changes that will be presented and voted on at the 83rd Supreme Growl, on 16 AUG 2023, in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. You will find those five changes here in this issue of the Woof-O-Gram. They are also posted on the Kennel website: MilitaryOrderoftheDevilDogs.org. Scroll down to: "2023 SUPREME GROWL" and click on the INFO tile. Scroll down to: "2023 PROPOSED CHANGES".

Here is a brief summary:

- 1. Stamps. This change would add several Passport Stamps to the authorized list.
- 2. KDOY Chair. This change calls for the Chair of the Kennel Dog of the Year Committee to be elected for a one year term.
- 3. KDOY Selection. This change would limit the selection process of the Kennel Dog of the Year to the KDOY Committee only.
- 4. Awards Submission. This change concerns the Pound and Pack Dog Robber of the Year. It would change the submission date, for Nomination Letters, to 1 June.
- 5. Pins. This change ads to the list of authorized pins on the MODD Collar. It would allow all MCL, MODD and Service pins.

Please take the time to read these and share them with your Pounds and Packs. Only the Dogs in attendance at the Supreme Growl will be able to vote on these proposed changes.

Proposed Bylaws Changes for 2023

1 = FIRST PROPOSAL

Subject: Proposed Military Order of the Devil Dogs Constitution & Bylaws Amendment

ARTICLE IV - THE KENNEL

Existing Wording:

Section 505 - Passports and Visa Stamps

A. All Devil Dogs shall procure a MODD Passport at a cost regulated by the Kennel, which will distribute them to the Packs and the Pounds. The fine for attending any Kennel, Pack or Pound Growl will be one dollar (\$1.00) without a passport in any attending Devil Dogs possession.

B. The Kennel, Packs and Pounds will procure a Visa Stamp to stamp all Passports with the date of all Growls attended by said Devil Dog presenting their Passport. Cost of Visa stamping shall be one dollar (\$1.00).

C. All monies collected for Passport or Visa stamping shall be forwarded after each growl to the Honorable Kennel Dog Robber, who will hold these monies in a special Passport account.

D. All monies collected will be used each year at the Marine Corps League, Inc., National Convention, where a check for a sizable portion of that account will be presented first, to a children's hospital in the convention city, or to another suitable local charity as the Executive Board of the Military Order of the Devil Dogs, Inc., may select. The check shall be accompanied by a letter stipulating that the Order's contribution is to be used for special equipment purchases only and for no other purpose.

E. Any Devil Dog Passport that is lost, or misplaced, not stolen, if turned into either the Kennel, Pack or Pound Dog Robber, shall be stamped four times and returned at a cost of two dollars (\$2.00), as a finder's fee.

Proposed Wording:

Section 505 - Passports and Visa Stamps

A. All Devil Dogs shall procure a MODD Passport at a cost regulated by the Kennel, which will distribute them to the Packs and the Pounds. The fine for attending any Kennel, Pack or Pound Growl will be one dollar (\$1.00) without a passport in any attending Devil Dogs possession.

B. The Kennel, Packs and Pounds will procure a Visa Stamp to stamp all Passports with the date of all Growls attended by said Devil Dog presenting their Passport. Cost of Visa stamping shall be one dollar (\$1.00).

C. Additional Passport stamps can be procured by the following Officers or Events of the M.O.D.D.: Pound Dog Robber, Pack Dog Robber, Pack Leader (Current and Past), Division Vice Chief Devil Dog (Current and Past), Kennel Dog Robber, Current Elected Kennel Officers, Chief Devil Dog (Current and Past).

Other Approved Stamps would be Pack Anniversary, Special Growls of the Kennel(Gatherings), Mini-Growl and Supreme Growl.

D. All monies collected for Passport or Visa stamping shall be forwarded after each growl to the Honorable Kennel Dog Robber, who will hold these monies in a special Passport account.

E. All monies collected will be used each year at the Marine Corps League, Inc., National Convention, where a check for a sizable portion of that account will be presented first, to a children's hospital in the convention city, or to another suitable local charity as the Executive Board of the Military Order of the Devil Dogs, Inc., may select. The check shall be accompanied by a letter stipulating that the Order's contribution is to be used for special equipment purchases only and for no other purpose.

F. Any Devil Dog Passport that is lost, or misplaced, not stolen, if turned into either the Kennel, Pack or Pound Dog Robber, shall be stamped four times and returned at a cost of two dollars (\$2.00), as a finder's fee.

Rationale:

The Passport Stamp is a way of increasing the amount of Bones delivered to the Childrens Hospital Fund. The proceeds of the Non-Dog Robber Passport Stamps will be Included in the Donation to the Childrens Hospital Fund as an Additional Donation. ONLY the Dog Robber Passport Stamps would be counted as Attendance for the Growl.

The PDD James F. Powell Award, which is named after our Kennel Quartermaster of many years, recognizes the Top Division in the Kennel for membership during the previous fiscal year.

Note 1: For each additional medal or ribbon award, a 5/16" gold star will be worn for each additional award, and a 5/16" Silver Star will be worn in place of five (5) gold stars.

Note 2: For each additional medal or ribbon award, a 3/16" bronze star will be worn in lieu of an additional medal/ribbon. A 3/16" Silver Star will be worn in place of five (5) bronze stars, and a 3/16" gold star will be worn in place of five (5) silver stars.

Note 3: As voting members of the Kennel Awards Committee, the Kennel Dog Robber and Kennel National Executive Director will be asked to provide supporting data attesting to the quality of reports submitted by nominees for the above awards.

Ref: Kennel Bylaws Article XIII Section 1301

I would like to recommend the following proposed bylaw change for consideration.

Article VII section 703, sub section C. Identification Disc and Dog Collar;

Currently reads:

C. A maximum of two (2) emblems, plus one official Dog Tag Disc, may be worn at any one time, on the Dog Collar. Emblems may include the American Flag, Marine Corps emblem, Marine Corps League Inc., membership pin, Military Order of the Devil Dogs, Inc., membership pin, the POW/MIA pin, the VAVS award for hours served (white oval pin with blue figure and red heart indicating number of hours served), and the Bull Dog. Except as may be specifically authorized elsewhere in these Bylaws, no other devices or emblems maybe worn on the Dog Collar. All other emblems shall be subject to one fine for each unauthorized emblem.

Change to read:

C. A maximum of two (2) emblems, plus one official Dog Tag Disc, may be worn at any one time, on the Dog Collar. Emblems may include the American Flag, Marine Corps emblem, Marine Corps League Inc. pins, Military Order of the Devil Dogs, Inc. pins, the POW/MIA pin, the VAVS award for hours served (white oval pin with blue figure and red heart indicating number of hours served), Military Service pins and the Bull Dog. Except as may be specifically authorized elsewhere in these Bylaws, no other devices or emblems maybe worn on the Dog Collar. All other emblems shall be subject to one fine for each unauthorized emblem.

Rational:

Members of our Order should be authorized to wear all Marine Corps League pins, Military Order of the Devil Dogs pins and Military Service pins.






All the activity at Mid-Winter did help to increase the sales of the online raffle, please continue to encourage Dogs and friends to purchase tickets.

It's time to start sending advancements to PDD applications in – remember they need to be in my paws NLT 1 July. **Hint- Hint**, they can be emailed to me after your Pack Dog Robber signs them. Per the updated bylaws the candidates for PDD must be in attendance by 1700 on Monday the 14th of August. Be sure to arrive early because you have to pick up your credentials from the MCL Registration prior to reporting to the Doghouse.

Passport stamping fees and donations to our Childrens Hospital Fund continue to arrive. Remember the bylaws require each pound to have a minimum of four growl each fiscal year and those bones collect for the stamping and donations to the Childrens Hospital are to be sent into me within a few days after the growl – so don't wait until the fiscal year is about over.



I continue receiving ROIs done on **OUTDATED** forms and with everyone living in the same **PO Box – it must be really crowded!!!** We need the physical address that your officers live at plus phone number and email address. Also, many pounds are still holding their elections prior to the Supreme Growl. Bylaws require the Pound election and installation to be done within **90 days after** the Supreme Growl.

My deputies are still finding many pounds and packs that are not incorporated and/or using incorrect EINs. We need to get this corrected ASAP – if you need help, just ask. We have many dogs that can assist you.

On another note: The Kennel has three major awards that are presented during the Supreme Growl. They are Kennel Dog of the Year. Kennel Pound Dog Robber of the Year and Kennel Pack Dog Robber of the Year of the Year. The nominations must be in my paws NLT 14 August. So far, only one nomination has come in. I know that there are dogs out there that are deserving of recognition. Let's see if we can get more than one or two nominations. For each category.

The Mini Growl held on 24 February in Norfolk, VA is on the website under private library. Check it out. If you need the password, check with the Pound Keeper, Pack Leader or Division VCDD.

Don't forget the cutoff date for donations for this year's convention is 30 June 2023.


