TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

Welcome to the 2018 Toro All Star Softball tournament. The following details are to provide you with the necessary information to enjoy your tournament experience and prepare your team and their traveling support network with the specific expectations of the tournament facility. We understand that some of this information may be different than what is customary, but feel that all are reasonable requests.

1. The tournament format is a 4 game guarantee. (3 pool play games on Friday/Saturday and single elimination on Sunday)

The Umpire in Chief will be identified each morning prior to the start of the games. If you have any comments or suggestions, positive and/or negative, please let us know.
3. Tournament schedules will be posted online at www.toro-softball.com and at the Toro Softball facebook page starting Wednesday May 30th.
4. The tournament facility is located at 22500 Portola Drive, Toro Park Elementary School. All games will be played at this facility on the three fields. We ask that teams and spectators remain in the field areas of the campus. There is a children's playground area for entertaining the youngsters.
5. Only one regular sized ice chest (filled with bottled water or sports drinks only) per team will be allowed into the facility. These items will be checked at the front gate. **Absolutely no other food or beverages will be allowed into the facility.** There will be a full service snack bar with a reasonable priced menu to accommodate breakfast, lunch and dinner in addition to snack options. This is a fundraiser for our Softball league and we do appreciate your support! Tailgating will not be allowed.
6. All players and up to 3 coaches will be allowed in for free each day. Daily Gate fees are \$5.00 adults (18-64), \$3.00 seniors (65+), \$1.00 Youth (14-17), under 13 are free. There will not be a charge for Friday admission.
7. This is a school campus so the following are not allowed: alcohol, smoking, chewing tobacco, scooters, rollerblades, bikes, skateboards, hover boards, etc. **No dogs** or other animals will be allowed on the facility.
8. Awards – Individual awards will be presented to the 1st and 2nd place teams.
9. Team Managers will be responsible for all persons including players and coaches as well as spectators associated with their team.
10. Please clean up after yourself and your team. There are sufficient trash and recycle receptacles available in various locations on the facility.
