**WHEREAS**, Project Enlightenment provides consultation and training for teachers at schools and childcare centers in the Wake County area and;


**WHEREAS**, multiple generations of Wake County children, their families and teachers have benefited from the wide array of early childhood services provided by Project Enlightenment and;
