WFHS JAGS FOOTBALL QBC MEETING OF 18 AUGUST 2015

6:00pm: Rusty Smith brought the meeting to order. Elizabeth Richardson offered the invocation.

ATTENDEES: See sign-in roster.

OLD BUSINESS:

Reviewed last week's Red vs. Black game.

New QBC Secretary established Jags Football Remind 101 messaging system.

NEW BUSINESS:

ITEM 1

Information: Jamboree this Friday evening at Pine Forest. Game begins at 7:30.

• All players will remain after school: They will be fed and bussed to/from the game.

• 1st Quarter: Freshmen

• 2nd Quarter: JV

3rd and 4th Quarter: Varsity

ITEM 2

Question: What is the typical plan (schedule) for game days?

Response:

- On Varsity game days, Freshmen and JV go home after school. They may ride to the game separately if they wish to come see it.
- On Freshmen and JV game days, Freshmen and JV players stay after school to ride the bus to the game. They may ride home with their parents after the game, but they must leave their jersey with the team so it can be washed
- JV games are scheduled first, so Freshmen must remain at the field throughout the duration of the JV game.
- Games are scheduled for two hours, but Freshmen games may begin early if the JV game finishes sooner.

ITEM 3

ITEM 10

Question: When will we get football pictures back, and is there a make-up day for those who missed it? Response:

- Allday has not finished printing. Last year photos were ready in time for the second game of the season.
- Photo make-up day will probably be on a Thursday. Date TBD.

ITEM 11

Question: What is the best way to share documents (schedules, POC lists, etc.)?

Response: Voting members agreed the best method is to publish documents on the website and/or FB page, then send a Remind message with a link to inform everyone that the information was available.

ITEM 12

Question: What is the relationship between the Jags gear pamphlet and the Boston Butt sales form that my son was given after practice yesterday?

Response:
